

Doctor of Ministry | Application Checklist

Priority Application Deadline: March 1 Final Application Deadline: July 1

1. Create an Account in the Portal Account created https://richmont.my.site.com/applicant/s/
 Application Form and Fee Online application completed (fee is paid at end of application)
3. A 40-hour Master's degree in Ministry with 11 hours of Bible and Theology, a previous Master's degree from Richmont Graduate University, or a related field of study
If an applicant has completed one of our partnership programs (i.e. Renovaré, Sustainable Faith, NICL, Transforming Center) and has obtained the appropriate certificate of completion, the 12 credit hours from those courses can satisfy the minimum theology requirement for the application.
4. Personal Statement Upload the essay into the applicant portal
Essay should be 500-700 words, double-spaced, and explain the applicant's intent behind applying for the Doctor of Ministry program at Richmont.
5. Academic Writing Sample Upload the writing sample into the applicant portal
The best option for this would be a research-based paper from your Master's program.
6. Resume Upload the resume into the applicant portal
Please include your education, work experience, and ministry and/or volunteer work.
7. References Three complete reference forms
Your references will receive the online reference forms directly via email from your portal.

8. Official Transcripts One official transcript from <u>all</u> post-secondary institutions attended
You'll need to request an official transcript from each post-secondary institution you've attended, even if you've transferred credits from one school to another. <u>Transcripts must be sent directly from each institution to Richmont.</u>
